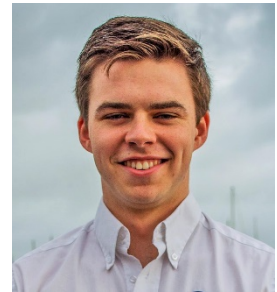

## PROFILE

Coming from a strong hotel background and working from a very young age to the exacting standards of the five star hotel business I have developed an eye for detail and level of hospitality that is not often found in someone so young, energetic and willing to work for long hours. This matched with my training and previous powerboat experience and qualifications means I am looking for a long term career in the superyacht industry and now I am seeking an entry deck hand position.

## YACHTING EXPERIENCE

### 1. UKSA September/2015-March/2016

Phase one of the Superyacht Cadetship at the UKSA is designed to train the cadets in seamanship, watch keeping, maintenance and industry knowledge. This is done over the course of 19 weeks, spending 60 days at sea covering over 2,500 nautical miles on vessels ranging from 12 to 20 meters. Over the 2,500 nautical miles we did extensive pilotage planning, close quarter maneuvering and daily mechanical checks needed to keep the vessel working 100% all the time.

### 2. Harbour Master April/2010-September/2015 Managing twelve boats ranging from 4 meters to 14 meters year round advising the owners on everything related to the running of their vessels.

### 3. Powerboat experience May/2008-Current in 2009 I started the Bull Run For Fun, a powerboat weekend aimed at getting likeminded boaters out on the water early in the season. Now it is one of Ireland's largest powerboat gatherings in Ireland. Since then I have covered many miles undertaking cruises all over the Irish coast and western Scottish Isles. In the winter of 2014 I completely rebuilt a RIB, learning all of the skills required, fibre glassing, painting and management with a tight build schedule and budget. This led to my appointment as Suzuki Marine Brand Ambassador, which brought me into the eye of the media where I have had many articles published in Motorboat Monthly and Powerboat & Rib.
